Situated in a tranquil neighbourhood near the Third Ring Road, Harrow Beijing City Campus shares the values, ethos and mission of the Hegezhuang Campus and follows the strategies and guiding statements of Harrow Beijing.

The City Campus also provides opportunities for new pupils to connect with and add to the rich traditions of our founding school, Harrow School London, through our core values – Courage, Honour, Humility and Fellowship.

Dedicated to providing excellent early childhood education, the City Campus ensures all students develop the skills, morals and conduct in line with global citizenship through positive contributions within the curricula and extra-curricular activities provided on site.



History

The City Campus was founded in 2005. It aimed to create an environment where older students (Y8 - Y13) from the international community could immerse themselves into the local culture of Beijing whilst studying a British curriculum.

Harrow Beijing moved into the purpose-built state-of-the-art Hegezhuang Campus in April 2013, as the school had developed into an “all-through school” which focused on educating students of all nationalities to take ownership of their progress from the Lower School through to the Upper School.

The City Campus has now been re-designed and transformed into a dedicated world-class campus for young pupils.



Facilities

The City Campus facilities include a fully kitted out Sports Hall and Dining Room, as well as a wide range of play-based creative spaces including a Maker Space, Construction Zone, Dance Studio, Visual Arts Studio and Music and Drama Studio. There is a Playground and Sports Pitch which has been designed to support the young pupils’ physical development.



Teaching Staff

Our City Campus teachers are highly motivated professionals in Early Childhood Education. They strive to develop the students' individual strengths and talents. The teaching staff are led by the Head of Early Years, Dr. Tina Stephenson. Dr Stephenson graduated from the University of Western Ontario with a Doctorate in Education Leadership (International Education).



Curriculum

Early Years

(for children aged 3 - 5)

Harrow Beijing City Campus provides an exceptional learning experience for children aged 3 to 5 years of age. Our AISL Harrow Early Years Curriculum (AHEYC) is specifically designed for the needs of our students and parents and draws from the very best practices of kindergarten curricula around the world. It specifically incorporates the core Harrow values of courage, honour, humility and fellowship, and adheres to the Guidelines on the Learning and Development of Children aged 3-6 issued by the Ministry of Education of China, ensuring that it is aligned to meet local and international standards. Central to the curriculum are ten Learning Domains and five Learning Disciplines. The blending of the Learning Domains and Disciplines delivers the core content that children will require in order to be appropriately informed, knowledgeable, and skilled. Together with our unique pedagogical approach, we holistically cultivate children's creative thinking, innovative skills and teamwork.

Year 1 - Key Stage One

(for children aged 5 - 6)

At City Campus, Year 1 students enter the first year of Key Stage One, of the English National Curriculum which is one of the best established and longest running curriculums in the world. Our Year 1 program includes all of the subjects of the National curriculum integrated through the International Primary Curriculum, with the core subject focus on Mathematics and English. This curriculum work is supplemented with the Harrow values of courage, honour, humility and fellowship, which are supported by our innovative approaches to supporting positive behaviour and emotional awareness. All of this adheres to the Guidelines on the Learning and Development of Children aged 3-6 issued by the Ministry of Education of China, ensuring that it is aligned to meet local and international standards. Students also receive comprehensive daily instruction in Mandarin and Expressive Arts. We are also very proud of the specialist emphasis on physical and social development through our extensive Physical Education and outdoor education programmes.

Extra-Curricular Programmes



The City Campus provides the pupils with an extensive variety of extra-curricular activities through Harrow's Leadership and Service Programme. Clubs including, but not limited to, Football, Ballet, LAMDA, Cultural and Community activities are provided after school for older pupils.
