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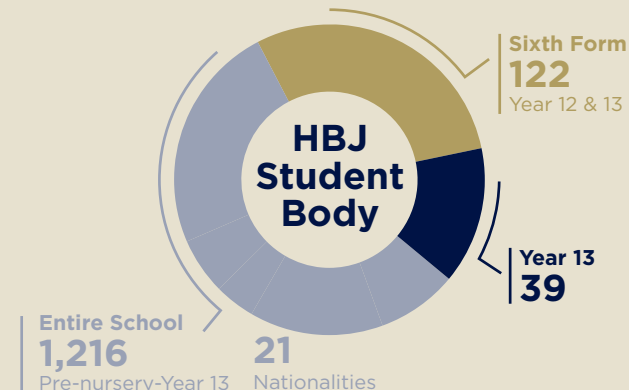

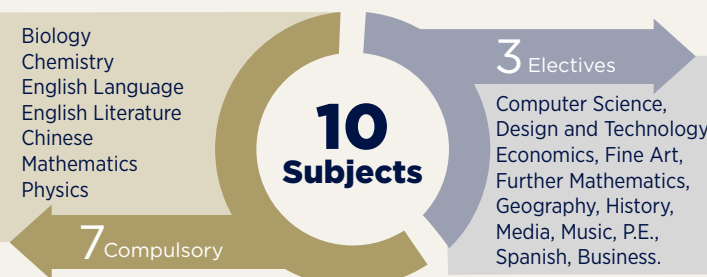
Harrow Beijing is affiliated with Harrow School London through AISL Harrow Schools with 13 international campuses across Japan, Thailand, Mainland China, and Hong Kong. All schools share Board of Governors with Harrow London.

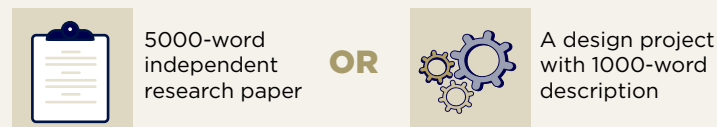


3 Year A-Levels

Year 13 Final Exams

This year, students will sit their modular AS exams in January 2026, except for History and Geography, which were done in June 2025. All A2 exams are in June 2026.

Though required and not reported on our transcript, students must take PE and Well-Being as part of our timetable and can opt to take Dance, LAMDA, Duke of Edinburgh International Award and Sports Leadership Award. All non-native English speakers in Year 12 take English for Academic Purposes (EAP) in support of meeting IELTS/TOEFL university entry requirements.

Leadership & Service Activities (LSA)

Students can participate in LSAs and sports including Intra-House competitions in debate, singing, House Music, Sports Day, charity fund-raising events and community service projects in addition to school drama productions.

CASE is an internal course for Year 12 students to develop well-rounded students through **Careers, Advocacy, Service, and Enrichment**, equipping them with real-world skills, purpose, and the act of doing citizenship. Its aim is to develop soft skills, and includes a 30-hour work placement at the end of Year 12.

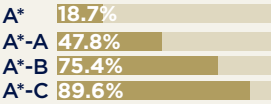
COVID Statement:

Since January 2020 through to December 2022 students had a minimum of 140 school days of online learning, though for individual students this could have been longer due to localized restrictions/home quarantine.

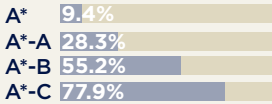

Harrow Beijing

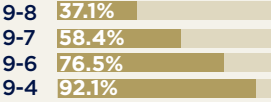

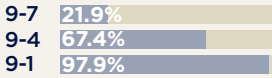
IGCSE CUM

We do not rank students or calculate GPA.

Our Transcript:

Transcript includes internal grades, I/GCSE final results, AS final results and A-level predicted grades. We ask students not to take AS/A-levels or EPQ externally as we are unable to give predicted grades and these courses are not reported on our school transcript. Prior to the academic year 2023/24 our school calendar was three terms.
